

Heart Flower with Crayon Tint Towel

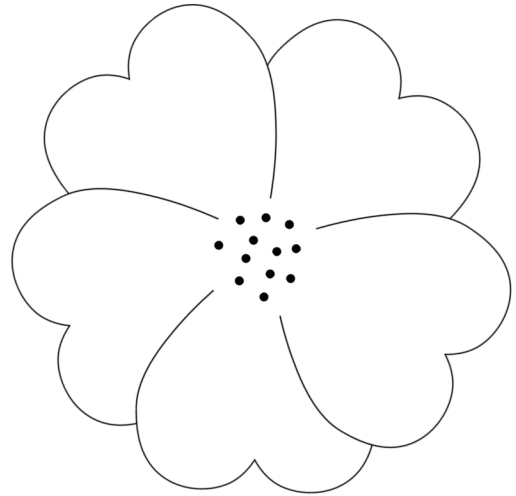
(Embroidery with Crayon Tinting Technique)

Class information

In this class you will learn the technique of using crayon tinting with your embroidery.
At the end of class you will have a complete or near complete embroidered dish towel.

Supplies

- Fabric
- Micron 05 Pen red, black or brown
- Crayola 24 Pack
- Fusible Interfacing 3x3
- 816 DMC Floss
- 840 DMC Floss
- Embroidery Needle
- Embroidery Hoop 4"
- Iron
- Pressing Board
- Paper Towel
- Freezer paper 4x4
- Cutting Mat
- Cutting Ruler
- Rotary Cutter
- Roxanne Basting Glue



Items for students to bring if they have them

- Micron 05 red, black, or brown pen
- Embroidery hoop 4"

Trace flower design on center of fabric with Micron pen.

Color entire flower with white crayon.

Tint center of flower with Dandelion

Tint flower pedals with Red and shading with Red Orange and

Using paper towel under and over fabric press with iron to set crayon. Use additional paper towel as needed till the paper towel is clean.

Center fusible interfacing on wrong side of fabric and steam press it in place

Stitch heart pedals with 816 DMC floss

Stitch center of flower with french or colonial knots using 840 DMC floss

Press finished piece, center and fuse freezer paper to front side of piece.

Trim to size of freezer paper with rotary cutter

Turn under 1/4 seam allowance and press.

On the center and 2 inches up from bottom of towel front, baste embroidery to towel and Roxanne Basting Glue

Sew buttonhole stitch around the embroidery piece to attach to towel using 840 DMC floss
